Summary

This role functions as an assistant specializing in botany and habitat restoration to support biodiversity and environmental management activities within a large-scale infrastructure project. The Reinstatement Assistant will work with relevant project teams and external consultants to support reinstatement requirements in sections of natural and sensitive habitats as defined by biodiversity management and environmental action plans, on an as-needed basis.

The role involves evaluating habitat restoration activities carried out by contractors, such as topsoil replacement, erosion control, nursery establishment, and ecological monitoring requirements. This is to support the implementation of location-specific restoration plans executed in the field by biodiversity restoration contractors.

- Assist in monitoring natural recolonization of flora and fauna within reinstated areas

- Support collection of restoration performance data, including vegetation cover, species diversity, survival rates, and habitat recovery indicators
- Monitor and report invasive alien species occurrences and evaluate effectiveness of control measures
